Their names were put in the deed Aaron Vannatta and Laura Vannatta, his wife, instead of Aaron Vernatta and Laura Vernatta, his wife. Having had personal knowledge of this transaction, and being well acquainted with these parties, I know they are one and the same people, and that the name being spelled Vannatta in the deed is a clerical error.
