Madison County,) I, Frederick Mott, being duly sworn, depose and say that prior to Oc-
tober 29th A.D. 1872, I purchased from Benjamin R. Johnson a certain promissory note call-
ing for Five Hundred (500) Dollars, and that said note was secured by a mortgage dated
December 31st, 1867, and filed for record January 14, 1868, and recorded in mortgage rec-
ord R, on page 467 thereof, upon the following described real estate, to-wit: the North
West Quarter (1/4) of the North-east Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirty-four (34), in Township
Seventy-five (75) North, in Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the 5th P.M., Iowa.

I further depose and say that said note the payment of which was secured by the a-
bove described mortgage, has long since been paid and satisfied, and that I was the own-
er of said note at the time it was paid, and that on October 29th, 1872, I entered the
following satisfaction upon the margin of the record where said mortgage is recorded:

"I hereby acknowledge satisfaction in full of the annexed mortgage, the note and mor-
gage of B.R. Johnson having been assigned to me", and that said entry is a statement of t
the facts and that I now have no claim whatever upon said land under and by virtue of sa
said mortgage, All of which is true, as I verily believe.
