That the C.D. Bevington and J.J. Hutchings, who together with their wives, Eliza Bevington and Mary Hutchings, conveyed the East Half (E.½) and the South west Quarter (S.W.¼) of the North east Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section Thirty-six (36) of Township Seventy-six (76) North of Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the 5th P.M.
