I, A.A. Dudney, being first duly sworn do depose and say, that I am a resident of Madison County Iowa, that my occupation is farming, and that I have no interest in making this affidavit other than to establish of record the facts set out herein.

That I am a son of the Abraham Dudney to whom a certain mortgage made by John S. Elliott and wife Tirzah J. Elliott to George F. Stallcup on the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 28 and the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 33, all in Township 74 North, of Range 27 West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, dated February 28th 1857, and recorded in Deed record B page 418 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, was assigned by John Long on June 30th, 1859, and that he is the same and identical person as the Abraham S. Dudney who assigned said mortgage to Joseph A Marley on the 9th day of July, 1859; that I was personally acquainted with the John Long who assigned said mortgage to the said Abraham Dudney on the 30th day of June, 1859, and that he is the same person as the John Long to whom said mortgage was assigned by C.W. Stallcup on the 15th day of April 1859, and that his correct name was John Long; that to the best of my knowledge there was no other John Long living in the neighborhood where said land was situated at that time, and no person by the name of John Long living in said neighborhood; all of which is true as I verily believe.
