To Whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that the undersigned persons and others have organized a corporation under Title IX of Corporations, Chapter 1, of the Code of Iowa and that they have filed their articles of incorporation with the Recorder of Deeds of Madison county, Iowa, and with the Secretary of State of the State of Iowa. The name of this corporation is the Winterset Business Men's Association, and its principal place of business is Winterset, Madison county, Iowa, and the object of said corporation is to promote the manufacturing, mercantile and all other business interests of the city of Winterset, Iowa. The amount of capital stock is five hundred dollars fully paid up; the amount of its indebtedness cannot exceed in amount two thirds of its capital stock, and the private property of the stockholders is exempt from liability for corporate debts. Said corporation commenced business on October 7th, 1902 and is to continue for a period of twenty years. The affairs of said corporation are to be managed by a board of seven directors. The annual meeting for the election of directors by the stockholders is the first Tuesday in October of each year, and the following persons are the directors for said corporation until the annual election in October, 1903, and until their successors are elected and qualified, viz. J. J. Gaston, C. T. Koser, M. E. Smith, J. H. Wintrode, J. E. Smith, C. L. Wilson and W. S. Cooper. The following persons shall be the officers of said corporation until the next election of officers, viz. President, J. J. Gaston; Vice President, C. T. Koser; Secretary, L. Lowe; Treasurer, M. E. Smith; the post office address of all officers and directors is Winterset, Iowa.
