This agreement made and entered into this 13 day of December A.D. 1902 by and between H.A. Baker of Scranton, Iowa, W. H. Baker and wife Emily Baker, E.H. Baker and wife Jennie Baker, E.R. Baker and wife Ida Baker, Amelia Banker and husband W.H. Banker, Rufus Baker and wife Daisy Baker of Vinterset, Iowa, and the only heirs at law of Ezekiel Baker deceased, **WITNESSETH:**

That whereas said Ezekiel Baker late of Madison County, Iowa, died intestate on or about the 13 day of Oct, 1902 possessed personal property to the value of about Fifty and no/100 (\$50.00) dollars, to which special reference is hereby made.

Whereas the said Ezekiel Baker, deceased did not die seized of any real estate: Therefore it is agreed by and between the parties hereto and with one another that in consideration of the love and affection which the parties hereto bear toward one another, and in further consideration of a desire upon the part of all the parties hereto, that said Rufus Baker shall be so far as possible recompensed for the money which he expended in the care, last sickness and funeral expenses, of their father Ezekiel Baker deceased.

It is expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that all of the personal property heretofore referred to and of which the said Ezekiel Baker died seized, shall be and hereby is turned over to the said Rufus Baker and each and all of the parties hereto, hereby, and herein do sign over to, and transfer to the said Rufus Baker, all their right, title and interest in the aforesaid personal property of Ezekiel Baker, deceased, in consideration of the aforesaid services in the care and defraying of the funeral expenses of their father the said Ezekiel Baker deceased.
