The affiant Mary B. Brundage states that her maiden name was Mary E. Bissell, and that she is a daughter of Fayette B. Bissell and his wife of Stewart, Iowa, but now of Dexter, Iowa, that she is the identical Mary Bissell mentioned in the fifth paragraph of a will of George W. Bissell, now deceased of date of the 19th day of October 1895 and admitted to probate in the Probate Court of Wayne County Michigan on the 4th day of October A.D. 1902, that her name was originally Mary E. Bissell but upon her marriage to B.R. Brundage she dropped her middle initial "E" and substituted therefor the letter B. as an initial thereafter writing her name Mary B. Brundage, that this affidavit is made for the purpose of explaining her signature to a certain note, and mortgage securing same, both of date October 17th 1904 and in favor of John B. Gibson for the sum of one thousand four hundred dollars and due November 1st 1909 said mortgage being executed upon lands devised to this affiant and others by said fifth paragraph of said will.
