To All to Whom these Presents shall come- Greeting:

Know Ye, That whereas, Philip M. Crapo died on or about the 20th day of September 1903 having left a last will and testament which nominated Henry G. Shelby of said County, Executor of the same, and the said testator having, at the time of his decease, personal property and effects in this State, which may be destroyed or diminished in value, if speedy care be not taken of the same. To the end, therefore, that said property and effects may be collected and preserved, and such disposition made thereof, as by said testator in his last will and testament directed and as by law required, the District Court of said County does hereby commission the said Henry G. Shelby as Executor of all and singular the goods, chattels, rights, credits and effects which were of the said Philip M. Crapo's estate at the time of his decease, with full power and authority to secure and collect the said property and debts wheresoever the same may be found in the state, and in general to do and perform all other acts which now are or hereafter may be required of him by law.
