Mabel Leonard, heir at law of Byram Leonard, deceased, on the following described premises, situated in the County of Madison, State of Iowa, to-wit:

the Northwest Quarter (N W $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township seventy-six (76), Range Twenty-eight (28), West of the Fifth P.M., and recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Madison, State of Iowa, in Mortgage Record 7 page 554, on the 17th day of February 1880, is redeemed, paid off, satisfied and discharged in full.

Addie K. Leonard. I further state that I am the person named in such mortgage as M. Mabel Leonard, the named therein being my mother. That said Addie K. Leonard died on the 7th day of February 1902, intestate and a widow. That I am her sole and only child and heir at law, she having left no other child nor any issue of any deceased child, surviving her.

That I was very familiar with the business affairs of my mother, and that since her death I have made diligent search for a note evidencing the indebtedness described in such mortgage, and I cannot find the same, and believe from my knowledge of my mother's affairs that there never was any note given for such indebtedness, or if there was such a note, that it was surrendered to said John Leonard, and I know that no such note was ever sold or transferred by my mother.
