I, Peter D. Hatfield, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I was one of the grantees in a deed of conveyance of the Northwest quarter of the North west Quarter of Section No. Thirteen in Township No. Seventy four, Range No. Twenty eight, West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Iowa made by Walter Needs and Lucy C. Needs, his wife, to Peter D. Hatfield and Charles H. Hatfield and dated September 13th. 1897, said deed appearing of record in Deed Record No. 39, of said County, on page 39 there of; that I also joined in a deed for the same land with Charles H. Hatfield to one Alice M. Hatfield on December 5th A.D. 1899, and that I executed the said deed as " P.D. Hatfield " instead of "Peter D. Hatfield " and that at the date of the said deed I was an unmarried man and that the grantee named in the said deed was on the date thereon the wife of said Charles H. Hatfield, one of the grantors; I further state that I again executed a conveyance of the said land as " P. D. Hatfield, (unmarried) to said Alice M. Hatfield on the 14th day of February A.D. 1900, and I further state that I am the same person who in the year 1897 joined Louisa E. Hatfield my wife and Charles H. Hatfield and Alice M. Hatfield his wife in Two Mortgages one being given to The Hawkeye Insurance Company and the other to Walter Needs and that since the execution of the said Mortgages and prior to the date of the first of the above mentioned deed my said wife Louisa E. Hatfield deceased and that I have ever since been a widower.
