I, J.C. Hoyt, Clerk of the District Court of Adair County, do hereby Certify, that as shown by the probate records of the said District Court, there was Filed in the Office of the Clerk of said Court, on or about the 27th day of March A.D. 1889, the Petition of one George Robertson, alleging that on or about the 6th day of March 1889, One Luther Gear died, in the said Adair County, Iowa, intestate, leaving personal property which might be lost or diminished unless some suitable person was appointed by the court to take charge of the same and asked he be appointed administrator of his said Estate; that one Elizabeth Gear as widow of the said Luther Gear, joined in asking the appointment of the said George Robertson as such administrator, said probate Records further show that the said George Robertson was appointed and that he duly qualified by the filing of the bond required and taking his oath for the faithful performance of his duty as such administrator; that notice of his said appointment as such administrator was given by publishing the same in the Greenfield Transcript a newspaper published in said County for two consecutive weeks the last publication thereof being on the 4th day of April 1889 that on the 5th day of April 1889, said administrator filed his Inventory of the personal property belonging to said Estate, and proceeded to, and did Administer upon said Estate, and on the 19th day of August, 1891, Filed his Final report as such administrator, alleging that all of the costs and claims against said Estate have been fully

paid, and on the same day gave notice of the Filing of his said Final report and the hearing of the same before said Court, by Filing Notice of the Filing of the same and the hearing to be had thereon, ten days before the term of said Court at which the same was heard, as required by the order of said Court, And on the 2nd day of Sept. 1891, by order of said Court, duly entered, in term time, said final report was approved, and the said George Robertson discharged as such administrator, his bond cancelled, and his bondsmen thereon released: The Court finding that said Estate had been fully administered, and all debts and claims against said Estate fully settled, all as shown by the said probate records in my said office.
