This inte-Muptial agreement, made and entered into by and between John Runsch of Dallas County, State of losa, party of tre first part, and S.J. Eernau of Kadison County, lowa, party of the second part, Witnesseth as follows:-

That said parties rereto contemplate entering into the marriage relation with each other, and in consideration of the second party marrying the party of the first part, the said party of the first part hereby agrees to provide for and support the party of the second part during her natural life.

It is further agreed by the party of the first part that he will and he does hereby waive and disclaim all dower, comestead right, and distributive share in the property of the party of the second part, including both real personal and mixed, and not only including that property which she now holds and own in her own right but also including all the separate property which she may hereafter acquire by inheritance or otherwise.

And it is further agreed by and between the parties hereto that during their said merriage the said S.J. Eernau is not to be restricted in the control or disposition of her separate property including both real and personal property which she may now have and also that which she may bereafter acquire, and that she may execute decis of conveyance therefor or incumber the same without the consent or signature of the said party of the first part the same as if they were unmarried.

At the death of the said party of the second part her separate property end effects are to decend and belong entirely to her children, and it is further agreed by and between the parties hereto, that should the first party die before the death of the second party that he will secure her by will in such an amount as to him may seem right ani just.
