Clark, who was the grantee in a deed dated Sept. 9th, 1890 from J.D. Clark and wife, conveying N¹ 52¹ & S¹ 2¹ N.E. 1/4 and E¹ 1/4 W¹ 1/4 NE¹ 31-77-27, Madison County, and that I was well and personally acquainted with the said J.D. Clark (my brother) grantor in said deed and well know that he is the same and identical person as James D. Clark, the maker of a mortgage on the said land to the Mutual Benefit Life Ins. Co. and that I am the same person as B.N. Clark the grantee in a deed from J.C. Thompson, of coal rights in said lands, dated Feb. 26th, 1894.

Further that I am and was well and personally acquainted with Westel T. Ford, grantee in a deed from Robert Shileds and wife of N¹ 1/4 S¹ 1/4 32-77-27, and know well that he is the same and identical person as W.T.
