Kale, who, with his wife Lizzie Kale, conveyed said real estate to H.A. Hayden by warranty deed dated February 22nd, 1900, recorded in Deed Record 41, page 319 of the records of said County.

I further state that I was well and personally acquainted with Margaret J. Robinson, who conveyed the said NW 1/4 NE 1/4 3-74-26 to Vertisha Johnson by warranty deed dated October 2nd, 1894, recorded in Deed Record 24, page 43, of the records of said County, and I personally know that said Margaret J. Robinson was the wife of Jeremiah Robinson, and joined with him in a subsequent conveyance of said land to Vertisha Johnson, conveying the same land.
