That, we W.V.Pyle and Emma E.Pyle his wife, J.D.Pyle and Hattie Pyle his wife, Emma Doty and F.C.Doty her husband, all of Madison County State of Iowa, and Henry Pyle and Delia Pyle his wife and Allen J.Pyle and Edna E.Pyle his wife of Polk County, State of Iowa, being the heirs and the only heirs and all the heirs of Snyder Pyle and Mary E.Pyle his wife both deceased, do hereby acknowledge satisfaction and payment of a certain mortgage, made and executed and delivered on the 9th of June, 1901, by Emma E.Pyle and W.V.Pyle her husband to Snyder Pyle of Madison County, State of Iowa, made to secure the sum of Eighteen Hundred (\$1800.00) Dollars, due June 9, 1906, upon the following described premises to-wit:
