I, J.N. Gordon, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:-

That I was personally well acquainted with David J. Martin who, on October 15th, A.D. 1853, filed an original entry under certificate # 824 covering the North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2) in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa and also with the David Martin who, together with his wife, Emily J. Martin, conveyed said real estate to James Rogers by deed dated October 15th, A.D. 1867 and personally know that the said David J. Martin, grantee, and said David Martin, grantor, as aforesaid, was in truth and in fact one and the same identical person.

I further depose and say that I was personally well acquainted with W.F. Hadley named as grantee in a certain deed from James Rogers and wife, Margaret, to said last described real estate, (except two acres in a triangular form out of the North East corner thereof), dated March 22nd, A.D. 1871 and who is also named in a bond for deed, as grantee, executed by Charles W. Huff covering the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2), in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, and other lands in Section One of said Township and Range, dated June 23rd, A.D. 1870; and also with the William F. Hadley named as grantee in a certain deed from William H. Evans and wife, Margaret A., conveying the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Two (2) in said Township and Range, dated September 30th, A.D. 1870; and also with the William F. Hadley who, with his wife Eliza A., is named as grantor in a deed to E.F. Russell, dated April 13th, A.D. 1879, conveying the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$), (except two acres out of the North East corner thereof) all in said Section Two (2) of said Township and Range and other land; and also with the Wm. F. Hadley, who, with his wife Eliza A., is named as grantor in a certain deed to William L. Koehler, dated April 12th, A.D. 1892, conveying

the real estate last herein described, and that the said W.F. Hadley; William F. Hadley and Wm.F. Hadley was in truth and in fact one and the same identical person.

I further depose and say that I was personally well acquainted with the C.W. Huff named as grantee in a deed from William L. Leonard, and wife Elizabeth, dated March 24 th, A.D. 1866 conveying Five (5) acres in a square form in the South West corner of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section One (1) in said Township and Range and with the Charles W. Huff, who, with his wife, Maggie A., is named as grantor in a deed to Charles R. Hadley, dated August 20 th, A.D. 1870, conveying said last described real estate and other lands and know of my own personal knowledge that the said C.W. Huff and Charles W. Huff was in truth and in fact one and the same identical person.

I further depose and say that I was personally well acquainted with the J.J. Hutchings named in a certain deed from Lytle Faurete and wife, Clarissa, dated January 27 th, A.D. 1858 conveying the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Two (2) in said Township and Range and with the Joseph J. Hutchings who, with his wife Mary, is named as grantor in a deed conveying the said last described real estate to Leander M. Sprague, dated March 4 th, A.D. 1859, and know of my own personal knowledge that the said J.J. Hutchings and said Joseph J. Hutchings was in truth and in fact one and the same identical person. I further depose and say that each, every and all of the foregoing facts and statements are known to me of my own personal knowledge and that I have no interest to serve either direct or indirect in making the foregoing affidavit.
