That I was well acquainted with Lorena Clanton and know that she was not married when she deeded 21 and 1/4 acres of the North side of the N.E.Qr.S.E.Qr.Sec.23-Twp.75,R.23.on April 28th 1865. That George Clanton was single Feb, 13th 1864. when he deeded a part of N.E.Qr.S.E.Qr.23-75-26, to Thomas N. Clanton That Thomas N. Clanton was single Jan 25th 1865 when he deeded his interest of the above tracts That I.W.Clanton and Isaac Wesley Clanton are one and the same person who deeded on April 22nd 1869 a part of N.E.Qr.of S.E.Qr.23-75-26 to Thomas N. Clanton, and he was at that time a single man; That I.N.Clanton and Thomas N. Clanton are one and the same person who deeded the N.E.Qr.of S.E.Qr.Sec.23-75-26 on Feb 4th 1867 to James P. Roach. I personally knew all the above named persons mentioned, and the dates of the conveyances I learned from an abstract prepared by E.E. McCall Dec 5th 1904.
