I, James S. Lorimer, of Madison county, Iowa, on oath say that I have been a resident of said County and State for Fifty two years last past; that I was a cousin and well acquainted with H.J. Lorimer, who on or about the 11th day of July, A.D. 1857, bought from John Lorimer, and wife the North half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section five (5), in township seventy four (74) North, of range twenty seven (27), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, the deed of conveyance being filed for record in Madison County, Iowa, and recorded in deed record "H" at page 84 thereof; that said H.J. Lorimer afterwards died in Madison County, Iowa, unmarried and without issue, and intestate; that he left surviving him his father, Alexander Lorimer, his mother have died prior to his death; that said Alexander Lorimer died in the year 1874, leaving surviving him his widow, Jane Lorimer, his second wife, and one son by his second wife, Joseph S. Lorimer, whose wife's name was Sarah C. Lorimer; that said Alexander Lorimer also left surviving him the following named children by his first wife, to-wit: Martha A. Roe, whose husband's name was Joseph Roe, Susannah McKnight, whose husband's name was J.B. McKnight, Margaret C. McConnell, a widow, John Lorimer, whose wife's name was Lib Lorimer, Amanda C. Lorimer, unmarried, A.C. Lorimer, whose wife's name was Lizzie B. Lorimer, A.W. Lorimer, whose wife's name was M.J. Lorimer, J.S. Lorimer, whose wife's name was B.A. Lorimer, and B.F. Lorimer, whose wife's name was M.E. Lorimer; that the said Jane Lorimer, Joseph Lorimer, and Sarah C. Lorimer, who on or about the 23rd day of May, 1876, executed to Jonas S. Ward and Isaac M. Ward, a quit claim deed to their interest in the above described real estate, was the aforesaid widow of said Alexander Lorimer, together with her said son and his wife; that the John Lorimer, Lib Lorimer, Amanda C. Lorimer, Lizzie B. Lorimer, B.A. Lorimer, M.J. Lorimer, M.E. Lorimer, A.C. Lorimer, J.S. Lorimer, A.W. Lorimer, B.F. Lorimer, Margaret C. McConnell, J.B. McKnight, Susannah McKnight, Joseph Roe, and Martha A. Roe, who on or about the -- day of January, A.D. 1855, executed a warranty deed conveying said real estate unto Wm. H. Hornback, the deed being recorded in deed record "P" of Madison County, Iowa, at page 394, were the aforesaid children of said Alexander Lorimer, by his first wife together with their husbands and wife, they being the full brothers and sisters of said H.J. Lorimer; that said Wm. H. Hornback was the same man as the Wm. Hornback, who with his wife Nancy, conveyed said land to O.P. Smith on or about March 5th, 1868, the deed being recorded in deed record "V" of Madison County, Iowa, at page 463 thereof; that said Jonas M. Ward and Isaac M. Ward, above referred to are the same and identical persons as the J.H. Ward and I.M. Ward, to whom said O.P. Smith and wife Nettie on or about August 23rd, 1875, conveyed the said real estate, the deed being recorded in deed record "11" of Madison county, Iowa, at page 340, That said J.H. Ward or Jonas H. Ward, to whom an interest in said land was conveyed as aforesaid was the same and identical person as the I.H. Ward, who on or about March 2th, 1877, conveyed an undivided one half interest in said land unto J.S. Ward, the deed being recorded in deed record "13" of Madison County, Iowa, at page 499 thereof; that the same appears of record as I.H. Ward through the mistake or error of the person drawing said deed or of the recorder, and that J.H. Ward was the person meant, and the person who executed said deed; that the I.M. Ward or Isaac M. Ward before referred to was the same person as the I.M. Ward, who with J.S. Ward and wife conveyed said land unto Oreeneth F. Smith on or about April 26th, 1877, the deed being recorded in deed record "13" of said County, at page 506 thereof.
