Field of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, all the right title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever I may have acquired in, through or by a certain indenture or mortgage Deed, bearing date the 9th day of August A.D. 1905 and recorded in the Recorder's office of Madison County, and State of Iowa, in Book 3 of mortgages Page 407 to the premises therein described, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) of Block Fourteen (14) of the Additional Lots to the town of St Charles, known as Hartman & Youngs Addition to the Town of St Charles.

And which said mortgage was made to secure one certain Promissory Note bearing even date with said Deed, for the sum of One Hundred Dollars and no cents.
