Miller conveyed the same land above described to Nicholas Shaver Jan. 3rd 1856 the deed being recorded in Deed Record "E" page 271 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that the said Joseph S. Miller and the said Joseph Miller are one and the same person.

Also that I was well and personally acquainted with Nicholas Shaver, Son, who was grantee in a certain deed dated March 9th 1889 conveying the E $\frac{1}{2}$ S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ 10-75-26 (and other land) and recorded in Deed record 22 page 589 of Madison County, Iowa and that I was well and personally acquainted with Nicholas Shaver, Widower, grantor in a certain deed dated October 1st 1890 conveying the land last described above and recorded in Deed Record 47 page 61 of Madison County, Iowa and that the said Nicholas Shaver, Sen. and the said Nicholas Shaver, Widower are one and the same person.
