State of Iowa, Madison County, ss.

I, T.D. Simon, of said County and State, on my oath say that I am a son of Christian R. Simon, who died testate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about September 30th, 1893; and that I am the same man as the T.D. Simon who afterwards commenced a partition proceeding for the partition of the land owned by my said father at the time of his death, which proceedings was commenced on or about February 2nd, 1894, in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa; that in some of the Probate proceedings in the settlement of my father's estate his name was given simply by his initials, as C.R. Simon, and sometimes his first name alone given as Christian Simon, but that in fact C.R. Simon and Christian Simon, was one and the same man, and was my father; that the C.R. Simons, as the name appears in a conveyance of the south west quarter of the north west quarter, and the north west quarter of the south west quarter of section thirteen (13), and other land in Township seventy five (75) north, or range twenty six (26), west of the 5th P.M., Iowa, was the same man as the said C.R. Christian Simon, and that the spelling of his name as Simons was a clerical error; that I had a sister named Ann Haworth, and that wherever in the probate proceedings in the settlement of my father's estate the name Ann Hayworth appears, it is simply a misspelling, and refers to my said sister Ann Haworth; that the name by which the wife of my brother David Simon generally went was Jane, and that her acceptance of service of the notice addressed to her, in said partition proceedings, as Mary Jane Simon, under the name of Jane M. Simon, was the way in which she generally signed her name, but that the Mary Jane Simon to whom said notice was addressed and the Jane M. Simon who accepted service was the same woman the wife of my brother David Simon.
