I further state that i forthwith took possession of said described real estate under said deed, so executed by the said John H. Kindle as attorney in fact for the said Jennett B. and Welford Kindle, and held open, undisputed, adverse possession of the same up to the 23rd day of February, 1901, when I conveyed same to N.T. Antle, no one, to my knowledge, ever questioning or disputing my full and absolute right thereto.

Wildey, which deed is recorded in book 18 of the deed records of Medison County, Iowa, and on page 184 thereof, and I know that at the time of the execution of said deed of date Oct. 21, 1879, the said Morgan S. Pollard and Mary J. Pollard were husband and wife; and that, if in the body of said deed or acknowledgement thereof, or in the signature thereto, the name Margon S. Pollard, or M.S. Pollard and wife conveyed certain real estate there in described, by warranty deed of date March 26, 1881, which deed is recorded in book 19 of the deed records of Madison County, Iowa, and on page 248 thereof, and am the identical person who conveyed to N.T. Antle, by warranty deed, of date Peby.23, 1901, certain real estate therein described, which deed is recorded in book 42 of the deed

records of Madison County, Iowa, and on page 494 thereof, my name being J. Godfrey Wetrich, sometimes by me written as J.G. Wetrich, one and the same.

I further say that I was well and personally acquainted with the Welford and Jennett Kindle, husband and wife, who, under date of March 10, 1877 executed their cortain mertgage, covering certain real estate therein described to H.G. Freeman, which mertgage is recorded in book 11 of the mortgage records of Madison County, Iowa, and on page 372 thereof, and I know that the said Jennett kindle, one of the mortgagors as above stated, is identical with the Jennett B.
