I, W.S. Cooper, being duly sworn depose and say:  
That I was well and personally acquainted with H. Galley who, on the 11th day of March, 1886, received a deed of conveyance from J.S. McCaughy and wife for the North West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Thirty-six (36) Township Seventy-six (76) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, which deed of conveyance is recorded in Madison County, Iowa, Deed Records No. 24, on page 544 thereof, and that said H. Galley on the 12th day of July, 1886, commenced an action in the Madison County District Court against Samuel B. Johnson, West Vawter & West, and Jane Ann Whodon, and that said Galley afterwards and on the 29th day of March, 1895, conveyed said land by warranty deed, which is recorded in Madison County Deed Record No. 35, on page 238 thereof, to one H.S. Butler and that said Galley in said deed of conveyance signed his name thereto as Henry Galley, and that I know of my own knowledge that Henry Galley signing said last mentioned warranty deed and H. Galley, the plaintiff in the above mentioned cause of action and H. Galley, the grantee in the deed from J.S. McCaughy and wife was one and the same person.
