Thompson, who, with Freeman Thompson joining, conveyed said land to William Fahy by deed dated September 13th, 1859, recorded in Madison County, Iowa, in Deed Record L. Thompson and Freeman Thompson were husband and wife at the time of making the above mentioned deed, to-wit, September 13th, 1859; that I was well and personally acquainted with the said William Fahy on June 7th, 1869, at the time he conveyed said land to Catharine Fahy by deed of said last mentioned date, recorded in Madison County, Iowa, in Deed Record No. 2, Pg. 5, and was also well and personally acquainted with the said Catharine Fahy at that time and well and personally know that they were husband and wife on the date of the execution of said deed, to-wit, June 7th, 1869.
