I, Ammon Lake, a resident of said County and State, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a brother of the Johnson Lake to whom Isaac W. Jackson and wife conveyed the North West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section One (1) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. by deed dated September 24th, 1868, recorded in Deed Record No. 1, Pg. 25 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that he is the same and identical person as Jonson Lake, who deeded said land to me by deed dated November 6th, 1869, recorded in Deed Record 3, Pg. 174 of the records of said County, and that the spelling of the name of the said grantor in said deed as Jonson Lake is an error and should have been spelled Johnson Lake; that I am the person to whom Catherine Fahy deeded the North East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section, Township and Range by deed dated July 14th, 1875, recorded in Deed Record 12, Pg. 91 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, my name as grantee in said deed being spelled Amon Lake by mistake, and that I am the identical person who, with my wife Martha A. joining, conveyed all said land above described and other land to David M. Tomlinson by deed dated May 16th, 1882, recorded in Deed Record 20, Pg. 222 of the records of said County.
