I, William Hartsook, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I have been a continuous resident of Madison County, Iowa, since the year 1853, and am the person to whom James W. Smoot and Jemima Smoot conveyed the North West Quarter (1/4) of the South West Quarter (1/4) of Section (1) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M., by deed dated September 6th, 1862, recorded in Deed Record K, Pg. 409 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and was well and personally acquainted with the said James W. Smoot and Jemima Smoot at the time of making said conveyance and know that on that date, to-wit, September 6th, 1862, they were husband and wife, and I further state that the said James W. Smoot is the same identical person as James Smoot who entered said land and to whom the same was patented by the U.S. Government on June 3rd, 1856.

I further state that I was well and personally acquainted with Alvin Snow to whom I, with my wife Catharine R. Hartsook joining, conveyed said land by deed dated January 2nd, 1868, recorded in Deed Record V, Pg. 167, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and, as I verily believe, he is identical with Alvin Snow, who conveyed said land to Isaac W. Jackson by deed dated June 8th, 1868, recorded in Deed Record V, Pg. 493 of the records of Madison County, Iowa.
