Hayward, Secretary of State of the State of Iowa do hereby certify that the South east quarter of the north west quarter of Section number three (3) in Township number seventy-seven (77) North, of Range number twenty eight (28) West of the fifth principal meridian was approved to the State of Iowa, March 26, 1859, for the use and benefit of the Mississippi and Missouri Rail Road Company, under the Act of Congress approved May 15, 1856, entitled, "An Act making a grant of lands to the state of Iowa in alternate sections to aid in the construction of certain railroads in said State", as the same appears of record in the State Land Office.
