I, Lorinda Taylor, of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say:—That I was one of the parties who were made defendants in an action in the District Court of Iowa, in and for Madison County at the April Term A.D. 1907, wherein Nathaniel Winship asked that the title to certain lands be quieted and established in him; that this affiant had due, timely and legal notice of the pendency of said action; that she made default; she claiming no interest in the land whatever.

Affiant further states that she is the same person as Lorinda Johnston mentioned in the registry of heir of John C. Johnston, deceased; that Nancy E. Johnston, was her sister, whose estate was administered upon in Madison County, Iowa, and that this affiant is the same person as Lorinda Bradshaw mentioned in the registry of heirs of the said Nancy E. Johnston.

Affiant further states the J.W. Bradshaw named in the report of sale of the interest of said Nancy E. Johnston, in certain lands sold by the Administrator to pay debts, which report was filed December 29th, 1883, and signified that J.W. Bradshaw had paid \$166.00 in cash to the administrator of the estate of said Nancy E. Johnston, for said lands which report was approved April 26th, 1884; and that the J.W. Bradshaw who was the grantee in a certain deed executed by Eliza Congdon and husband and which deed is recorded on Pg. 154 of Deed Record, 21 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa, was the husband of this affiant, and was the same person who joined in a deed with this affiant and Catharine Bean, under the name of J.W. Bradshaw, Jr.,
