I,E.R.Mason, Clerk of said Court for said District, do hereby certify that on the 7th day September, A.D. 1878, there was filed in the office of the Clerk of the United States Circuit Court for the District of Iowa a bill of complaint #1187, Equity, by Tyler Palmer against William McConkey and Sarah J.McConkey to foreclose a mertgage given by the said William and Sarah J.McConkey to the said Tyler Palmer on June 1st, 1873 on the following described real estate, to-wit:

The west half of the North East Quarter and the North East Fourth of the North West Quarter of Section Twenty-six (26) and fifteen (15) acres off the South end of the West Half of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty-three (23) all in Township Seventy-six(76) North Range Twenty-seven(27)West, containing 135 acres together with all and singular the tene-Range Twenty-seven(2//west, containing 155 acres together with all and singular the tenemonts, hereditaments and appurtenances thereinto belonging or in anywise appertaining, which
said "espondents and recorded in the bottle for recording deeds in Madison County, Iowa, in
Book No.4 of Mortgages on page 214, on the tenth day of June A.D. 1873. Said mortgage made to
secure a note given by the said William McConkey on June 1st, 1873, for the sum of Twelve
Hundred Dollars (\$1200) with interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum payable semiannually, principal and interest payable at The Bank of Warsaw, Warsaw, New York, unpaid inter est to bear interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum.

That on the some day, to-wit: September 7, 1678, there was issued out of said Clerk's Office in said cause a subpeona in chancery directed to the said William McConkey and Sarah J.McConkey, which said subpoons was served by the United States Marshal as follows: "On the within named William McConkey and Sarah J. McConkey by reading the same to each of them on the 14th day of September, 1878, and by delivering a true copy of the same to each of them at Union Township in the County of Madison and State of Iowa", which said subpoena in chancery 1933 returned and filed in said Clerk's office on September 30, 1878.

That afterwards such proceedings were had as that on the 11th day of November, 1878, decree of foreclosure was entered in said cause and appointing Edward R. Mason Master in Chancery of said court to sell the pr perty above described upon default in payment of the amount due upon the note and mortgage.

I further certify that by virtue of the Act of Congress of July 24th, 1882, all records in cases pending and disposed of in the United States Circuit Court for the District of Iowa became and are a part of the records of the United States Circuit Court for the Southern District of Iowa, and as such are in my custody.
