I, Jerome Morgan, being first duly sworn, do upon my oath depose and say; That I am a son of Oliver Morgan, who died about November 3d, 1877, and Roanna Morgan, who died about June 23, 1878, and that I now reside at Frederick, Oklahoma, and that I am a brother of one Sarah Kimmerer, who was a daughter of the said Oliver and Roanna Morgan, and that the person named as Sarah Keinoren, in the action for partition, at No. 3522 of the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, in which action, the petition was filed on March 1st, 1881, in said Court, and the person named in the affidavit for the service of publication in said cause, as Sarah Keinoren, and the person named in the decree entered in said cause, as Sarah Kimorn, and also named in the said decree as Sarah Kimmer, is the same person as Sarah Kimmerer.

I further state that my said sister, Sarah Kimmerer, had actual knowledge of the commencement of said action for partition, and of the fact of said partition having been made by sale of the real estate involved in said action, and that sometime prior to the 29th day of November, A.D., 1881, the said Sarah Kimmerer executed to me a written power of attorney, directing me, and empowering me to do any and all things necessary in making settlement with the referees, who had been appointed in said partition suit, and empowering me to receipt for her share of the proceeds of the real estate involved in said partition action and further state that I did, on or about the 29th day of November, A.D. 1881, receive from the referees in said partition action, all of the money due to my said sister, Sarah Kimmerer, and I, at that time, receipted for the same as her attorney in fact.

And I further state that thereafter, within a short time, I turned over to my said sister, Sarah Kimmerer, all of the money which I had received as above stated, as her share of the proceeds of said real estate in said partition action, and she so accepted the same.

I further state that the person named in said partition action as William Keinoren, and also named as William Kimner, was the husband of my said sister, Sarah Kimmerer.

I further state that I am the same person who executed the deed to Louise M. Reed, on

the 27th day of December, 1878, which deed was filed for record February 1st, 1879, and recorded in "Deed Record 16", at page 542 of the deed records of Madison County, Iowa, and that at the time of the execution of said deed, I was an unmarried man, and that I am still an unmarried man, never having married.
