I, Porter Rollstin, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, continuously for more than fifty years last past. That I am the same man to whom Josephus Harrell on or about the 17th day of February, 1866, conveyed the south half (½) of the north east quarter (¼) of the south west quarter (¼) of section three (3), in township seventy five (75) north, of range twenty seven (27), west of the 5th P.M., Iowa, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record "P" of Madison County, Iowa, on page 542 my name being spelled therein Porter Ralston; that I am also the same man, who conveyed the same land to Owen K. Vanscoy on or about January 23, 1875, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record eleven (11) of Madison County, Iowa, at page 34 thereof, my name being spelled therein as Porter Ralston. That the grantee in said deed from me, although his name appears of record as O.K. Vanscoyoc was in fact Owen K. Vanscoy, with whom I was well acquainted; that he was also the same man as the Owen K. Vanscoyoc to whom Asa Poleson and wife Alvira C. Poleson on or about the 14th day of January, 1868, conveyed the south east quarter (¼) of the south west quarter (¼) of the same section, township, and range, the deed being recorded in deed record one (1) of Madison County, Iowa, at page 109 thereof; that he was also the same man as the Owen K. Vanscoyoc who on or about July 2, 1872, conveyed the last described forty acre tract to his wife Rosa Ann Vanscoyoc, the deed being recorded in deed record seven (7) of Madison County, Iowa, at page 90 thereof. That he was also the same man as the O.K. Vanscoyoc to whom Casper Armbrist conveyed the north east quarter (¼) of the north east quarter (¼) of the south west quarter (¼) of the same section, township, and Range, on or about March 1, 1875, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record eleven (11) of Madison County, Iowa, at page 353 thereof; that he was also the same man as the Owen K. Vanscoyoc to whom George W. Broeding conveyed the north west quarter (¼) of the North east quarter (¼) of the south west quarter (¼) of the same section, township, and range, on or about January 16th 1872, the deed of conveyance being filed for record in the office of the recorder of Madison County, Iowa, on the day of its date and recorded in deed record six (6) at page 274 thereof; and that he was also the same man as the Owen K. Vanscoy, who with his wife Rose A. Vanscoy conveyed the east half (½) of the south west quarter (¼) of the same section, township, and range, to J.S. McCaughan, on or about April 16th 1879, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record eighteen (18) of Madison County, Iowa, at page 12 thereof. In other words the said O.K. Vanscoyoc, Owen K. Vanscoyoc, and Owen K. Vanscoy was one and the same man, as I know from my personal knowledge. That the Josephus Harrell who conveyed the tract first above described to me was the same and identical man as the Joseph Harrell, to whom Chester D. Horrell conveyed the same tract on or about November 29th, 1860, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record "L" of Madison County, Iowa, at page 564.

All this I know of my personal knowledge, and I am not in any way interested herein.
