Danforth, the grantee in a deed from William Davis and Naomi Davis, dated May 16th, 1871, recorded in Deed Record No. 4, on page 595 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying Lot Five (5) and the West Half (1/2) of Lot Six (6) in Block Six (6) of the Original Town of Winterset, Iowa, and that my acquaintance with the said Mary A. Danforth extended from the beginning of my residence in said County and State until the time her death, which occurred about the year 1878.

That to the best of my knowledge and belief the said Mary A. Danforth left no will. That the husband of the said Mary Danforth died prior to the time of my acquaintance with her, and that she was a widow during all the time of my acquaintance with her and at the time of her death. That the said Mary A. Danforth left surviving her as her sole and only heirs at law, her two sons, William R. Danforth and Challen Danforth.
