I, Jas. S. Eby, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than fifty years last past; that I was well and personally acquainted with William F. George who died testate in Madison County, Iowa, about the year 1885, owning the east half (1/2) of the south west quarter (1/4) of section thirty-four (34), in township seventy six (76) North, of Range twenty-nine (29), west of the 5th P.M. Iowa; that the said William F. George was the same and identical man as the W. F. George to whom C. D. Bevington and wife conveyed said land on or about the 9th day of May, 1876; that said William F. George left a son commonly known as Ora George, but who was named in the will of his father as Orlando H. George and who was the same and identical man as the Ora H. George, who on or about March 4th, 1892, conveyed said land unto William Reed.

That I was personally acquainted with C. D. Bevington, who on or about the 18th day of August, 1874, conveyed unto said William Reed the North west quarter (1/4) of said section, Township, and range, and that he was the same and identical man as the Charles D. Bevington grantee in a conveyance from Luther A. Martin and wife of the same real estate dated on or about December 22nd, 1873.

That all of the above statements are true to the best of my information and belief; that I know personally all of said parties, and have known the said land, and those in possession of it for more than forty years last past, and I am not interested in this matter.
