I, S.M. Hamilton, of said County and State on oath say that I was a resident of Walnut Township, Madison County, Iowa, during the years 1890 to 1900; that I was personally acquainted with Henry Smith, who on or about February 27th, 1902, conveyed unto F.M. Frederickson, now deceased, the East half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the south east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the east half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the west half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the south east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section twenty five (25), township seventy four (74) north, of range twenty seven (27), west of the 5th P.M. Iowa, the deed being recorded in deed record forty three (43) of Madison County, Iowa, at page 303 thereof; the said Henry Smith did not live in Webster township, Madison County, Iowa, and had no property therein during the years 1894 and 1895, and that the Henry Smith against whom unpaid personal taxes for either of those years in that township are listed is not the Henry Smith who was grantor in said conveyance; that the name of the grantee in said conveyance where it appears as Fritz Friedrichson, as the spelling of his name in the German manner, and that said Fritz Friedrichson named as grantee was in fact the same and identical man as the F.M. Frederickson who died in Madison County, Iowa, in April, 1907, and whose estate is now being settled in the District Court of said County.
