I J.R.Davis of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I am a son of William Davis and Elizabeth Davis and the same and identical person to whom they conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 on December 2nd, 1858 and I well and personally know that on said date they were husband and wife and I further depose and say that Margaret Davis who joined with me in a deed dated October 17th, 1866 conveying the W $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 to William Davis was on that date my wife, and I well and personally know that W.Davis who together with his wife conveyed all that part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 that lies North of Cedar Creek to John D. Brassfield on January 22nd, 1868 was the same and identical person as William Davis to whom I conveyed said land, and I further state that George W. Shell who together with his wife conveyed the North 60 rods of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 to John D. Brassfield on February 19th, 1872 was the same and identical person as George Shell to whom said land was conveyed.
