I, Mary E.S. Robinson, of lawful age, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say, that I am the same person, who under the name of M.E.S. Rodgers joined with Margaret Rodgers my mother in the execution of a warranty Deed dated September 11th, 1855 conveying to one Isaac Stevens, the E. 1/2 SW Qr. Sec. 33 Twp. 74 Range 28 West of the 5th P.M. and recorded in deed record P. page 351 of the records of Madison County, Iowa.

That at the date of the execution of said deed, the said Margaret Rodgers was a widow and unmarried. That when I as M.E.S. Rodgers joined in the execution of said deed, I was single and unmarried, and did so join in the execution thereof in error, as I never acquired any title in the land conveyed thereby, and in fact had no title therein at any time.

That I was well and personally acquainted with the John J. Rodgers who entered the NE 1/4 SW Qr. Sec. 33 Twp. 74 R. 28 West of the 5th P.M. under certificate of purchase No. 31978, dated April 4th, 1856 and the John L. Rodgers who entered the SE 1/4 SW Qr. Sec. 33 Twp. 74 Range 28 West of the 5th P.M. under certificate of purchase No. 14069, dated April 8th, 1856, and that they were one and the same identical person, and the same person as the J.J. Rodgers who with his wife Ann M. Rodgers, conveyed the above described land to my mother Margaret Rodgers by deed dated October 4th, 1864, and recorded in deed record P. page 278 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and the same person as the John J. Rodgers, who with his wife Ann M. Rodgers conveyed the above described land to my mother Margaret Rodgers by Quit Claim deed dated March 23rd 1868, and recorded in deed record W. page 171 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that his correct name was John J. Rodgers, and that he was my Uncle, and that wherever his name appears in the title to the above described land as John L. Rodgers, or J.J. Rodgers, it is an error of the scrivner.

I Make the above statements from my own personal knowledge of the facts.
And further deponee saveth not.
