I, William Arthur Gustine Leas, a resident of said County and State, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a son of William Henry Leas and Mary Jane Leas, and that I am the only heir at law and devisee under the will of the said William Henry Leas; that the said William Henry Leas owned a number of tracts of land in Madison County, Iowa, during his life time, and that any such which he owned at the time of his death were bequeathed to me under his said will, but the particular descriptions of any of said tracts I do not now recall; that I recall conveying a tract of land about 45 acres in Madison county, Iowa, to one whom I believe was J.M. Simpson, but the description of the land conveyed to him I do not recall; this conveyance was made about the year 1893; and my title thereto was derived under the said will of William Henry Leas; that where the names, William H. Leas, Wm. Henry Leas, and W.H. Leas, Mary Jane Leas, Mary J. Leas, appear in connection with the title to any land at one time owned by my said parents in Madison County, Iowa, the same refer, respectively, to my said parents; that my said mother, Mary Jane Leas, died about 8 years prior to the death of my said father, William Henry Leas.
