I, Kate A. Wray, of said County and State, on oath say that I am a daughter of Israel D. Guiberson, who on or about September 6th, 1854, purchased from Charles D. Bevington (under his initials C.D. Bevington) and wife, Lot one (1) in Block sixteen (16) in the original town of Winterset, Iowa; that said Israel D. Guiberson died in the year 1858 intestate, leaving his widow Elizabeth P. Guiberson, and two children, Willis P. Guiberson, and myself, named in the registry of heirs of my father's estate as Catharine Guiberson; that my mother afterwards married William M. Knowlton, who died about twenty years ago, and that my mother, Elizabeth P. Knowlton died in the year 1893, leaving in addition to the said Willis P. Guiberson and myself, one other heir Cora K. Eyer, the wife of C.B. Eyer, the said Cora K. Eyer being the child of my mother's second marriage.

That the estate of my father Israel D. Guiberson was long since fully settled.

That the H.L. Joeckel to whom myself and husband conveyed said property on July 9th, A.D. 1894, was the same man as the Henry L. Joeckel who afterwards conveyed the same premises to Jay Jacobs, the last mentioned conveyance being made on or about November 5th, 1902.
