Decree.

This cause having been brought on to be tried on this 19th day of October A.D. 1904 said day being one of the regular juridical days of the October Term, A.D. 1904, of said Court upon the complaint of the Plaintiff and the Answer of the Defendant thereto, the said plaintiff appeared by F. S. Luethi, her attorney, the said defendant appeared by John R. Wolff his attorney, A Jury of--persons was regularly empaneled and sworn to try the question of the guilt or innocence of the defendant of the matters charged in the complaint and a true verdict render according to the evidence. And the Jury, having heard all the evidence, the instructions of the court, and the arguments of Council, having duly returned their verdict in to Court, and having found that the said defendant is guilty of the matters charged in the complaint; and the Court finding that the material allegations of the plaintiff's said complaint are sustained by the evidence; that said evidence is free from all legal exceptions; that the said plaintiff was personally present at the trial of said cause, and is now and has been for at least one whole year last past, prior to the commencement of said action a bona fide resident and citizen of the State of Colorado; that a contract of marriage was solemnized between the plaintiff and defendant at Adair County, in the State of Iowa, on or about the 23rd day of March A.D. 1891, and they are now husband and wife; that since said marriage the said, has been guilty of numerous and repeated acts of extreme cruelty towards Plaintiff and that since said marriage defendant has been guilty of adultery, that said matters alleged and proved in behalf of the plaintiff are sufficient in law to entitle him to the relief prayed for in his said complaint, and the Court further finds that said parties had as the issue of their said marriage six children now living, to-wit:

Jessie E. Fox age 12 years, Ethel Fox, age 10 years, Imogen Fox age 8 years, Charles E. Fox age 7 years, Bruce Fox, age 3 years and Paul Fox age 1 year and being now sufficiently advised in the premises after due deliberation thereon, had and upon motion of F. S. Luethi attorney for the said plaintiff, it is ordered by the Court that a Decree be granted and entered herein in accordance with the prayer of said plaintiff's complaint in this behalf on file herein.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore and now existing between the said plaintiff Carrie E. Fox and the said defendant John L. Fox be and the same are hereby dissolved, and that said parties are and each of them is freed and absolutely released therefrom, and that all and every duty, rights and claims accruing to either of said parties by reason of said marriage shall henceforth cease and determine.

And it is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that until the expiration of the full period of one year from and after the day of the date hereof that neither of said parties be permitted to remarry to any other person.

And it is Further Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed By the Court that the sole care and custody and control of the said minor children Jessie E. Ethel, Imogen, Charles E. Bruce and Paul Fox be and the same is hereby awarded to the said plaintiff until the further order of this Court in the premises, and that the said defendant John L. Fox pay the costs of these proceedings to be taxed.
