Macy, plaintiff vs. Isreal Hall, et al defendants, in quieting title proceedings had upon above described premises; that I was also well and personally acquainted with Albert C. Macy in "Petition to complete contract" had in the probate court of Columbiana County, Ohio referred to as being the purchaser of above described premises; also with A.C. Macy in decree dated July 24th, 1867 and I do state that the said Albert C. Macy; A.C. Macy; Albert C. Macy and A.C. Pierce, who releases said mortgage as shown by book 1 page 495 Madison County, Iowa records, and I do state that the said Joseph A. Pierce and the said J.A. Pierce referred to and was one and the same identical person, Joseph A. Pierce.

I depose and further state that I was well and personally acquainted with Christian B. Kauffman, grantee in a certain warranty deed, conveying the following described premises, to-wit: Commencing at the Southwest corner of the NW. 1/4 6-77-29, running East 80 rods; thence running North 40 rods, thence running west 80 rods, thence running South 40 rods to the place of beginning, that I was also well and personally acquainted with C.B. Kauffman, one of the grantors in a certain warranty deed, conveying the premises last above described, and recorded in book 11 page 101 Madison County, Iowa records and I do state that the said Christian B. Kauffman and the said C.B. Kauffman referred to and was one and the same identical person, Christian B. Kauffman.

I depose and further state that I was well and personally acquainted with C.D. Trego, grantee in a certain warranty deed, recorded in book 11 page 101 Madison County, Iowa records and I do further state that I was well and personally acquainted with Curtis D. Trego who died testate, and whose will was admitted to probate in Madison County, Iowa on the 6th day of November A.D. 1883, and in which will his wife, Mary Trego was the sole beneficiary and I do state that the said C.D. Trego and the said Curtis D. Trego referred to and was one and the same identical person; and I further state that all debts against said estate were fully paid by the beneficiary, Mary Trego and that said estate was settled by the beneficiary without the intervention of the probate court, other than the probating of the said will of the said Curtis D. Trego.
