State of Oregon, Wasco County, ss:

I, Charlotte Phillips, of said County and State, but formerly of Madison County, Iowa, on my oath depone and say that I am the widow of Levi Phillips who entered from the United States Government, and to whom was patented, the south east quarter (1/4) of the south east quarter (1/4) of section two (2) in township seventy six (76) north, of Range twenty seven (27), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, being in Union township, Madison County, Iowa; that in the year 1857 myself and husband were residing in the immediate vicinity of said tract, if not on the tract itself, and that for many years thereafter we lived and resided in the immediate neighborhood and vicinity of said tract.

That on or about the 29th day of August, A.D. 1857, myself and husband sold and conveyed said tract of land to a man who also resided in the vicinity, and with whom I was acquainted, whose name appears in the record of said deed as James M. Johns, the said deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record "L" of Madison County, Iowa, at page 314 thereof; that on or about the first day of September, A.D. 1857, the said grantee in said conveyance from myself and husband, together with his wife, sold and conveyed said tract of land unto D.F. Turney, commonly known in the neighborhood as Dan Turney, the deed of conveyance being recorded in deed record "L" of Madison County, Iowa, at page 513 thereof; that in the record of said last mentioned conveyance the name of the grantors appears as James M. Jones and Elizabeth R. Jones, while in the acknowledgement the names appear as James M. Johns and Elizabeth R. Johns; that said conveyance was acknowledged before my said husband as Justice of the Peace, and the grantors therein was the man to whom we had sold and conveyed and his wife; in other words the grantee in the conveyance from myself and husband, and the grantor in the conveyance to D.F. Turney was one and the same man.

That I was well acquainted with all the persons named herein at that time, and personally knew of the transactions, and was connected therewith, and that I make this affidavit for the purpose of making of record the facts regarding said conveyances, and identifying said parties.
