I, J.K. Pleasants, of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Theodore Livings who on September 9th, 1859 conveyed the SE 1/4 (27) & NE 1/4 34-75-29 to Fredrick Strubbi and I well and personally know that on said date the said Theodore Livings was an unmarried man of lawful age and competent to convey real estate, and that he was the same and identical person who entered said land and to whom the same was patented and I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Fredrick Strubbe who on August 3rd, 1861 conveyed said land to William Hall and James K. Pleasants and I well and personally know that on said date the said Frederick Strubbe was an unmarried man of lawful age and competent to convey real estate and that he was the same and identical person as Fredrick Strubbi to whom said land was conveyed by Theodore Livings.
