William Brinson of said County and State, being first duly sworn according to law, depose and say:-

That I was well and personally acquainted with William Harmon and Sarah Harmon, on April 9" 1866, at which time they conveyed to John H. Harmon, certain lands in Madison County, Iowa, by Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record "1" page 439, and that at the date of said conveyance the said William Harmon and Sarah Harmon were husband and wife.

That I was also well acquainted with David Huff the grantee in Warranty Deed from John H. Harmon and wife dated March 20" 1875, and recorded in Deed Record "11" page 159, and that the said David Huff is the same identical person as David Hoff the grantor in Warranty Deed to David Holgarth, dated Nov, 24" 1876, and recorded in Deed Record "13" page 293.

That David Holgarth the grantee in the last described deed and David Holgarth the grantor in Warranty Deed to T.G. Ladd, dated September 4" 1884 and recorded in Deed Record "23" page 588, are one and the same identical person.

That I was also well acquainted with John H. Harmon the Mortgagee in a certain Mortgage executed by David Hoff, and recorded in Mortgage record "7" page 4, and that he is the same identical person as J.H. Harmon the grantor in the release of said Mortgage, recorded in Miscellaneous Record "3" page 51.
