I, Hannah M. Courtney, being duly sworn on oath state, that W.H. Steele was my father and that he is the same identical person who as W.H. Steel received a warranty deed from J.W. Hampton and wife October 27th 1881 conveying the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 30-74-28 Madison County Iowa; that he died leaving a widow Elizabeth E. Steele, no issue of deceased Children and only the following children and heirs, James L. Steele, Hannah M. Courtney Phillip T. Steele, Sadie E. Steele, Abigail J. Steele, Minnie B. Steele and Ellen E. Steele; that upon the 11th day of February 1891 a Quit-Claim deed conveying the above described land was executed to James L. Steele; that in this Quit Claim deed I signed my name as Hannah M. Courtney and my brother signed his name as Phillip T. Steele and that we are the same identical persons mentioned in the probate proceedings, and shown at Number 10 of the abstract, as Hannah Courtney and Phillip L. Steele.
