pose and say that I was well acquainted with Johnathan Smith who purchased the West Half
($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 13, Township 77,
Range 27, of Francis S. Trunkley, and received a warranty deed of date July 14, 1875, and which
deed is recorded on page 269 of Deed Record 11 of the records of Madison County, Iowa and to
my personal knowledge he is the same person as Jonathan Smith who was the grantor in a
deed dated March 1, 1902, and which deed is entered of record on page 294 of Deed Record 45
