## Discharge of Bankrupt:

District Court of the United States, Southern District of Iowa.

Whereas, George W. Myerly of Douglas Township Madison County, in said district, has been duly adjudged a bankrupt, under the Acts of Congress relating to bankruptcy, and appears to have conformed to all the requirements of law in that behalf, upon motion of Dabney & Cooper attorney for said bankrupt, it is therefore ordered by this court that said George W. Myerly be discharged from all debts and claims which are made provable by said acts against his estate, and which existed on the 23rd day of April A.D. 1900 on which day the petition for adjudication was filed by him, excepting such debts as are by law excepted from the operation of a discharge in bankruptcy.

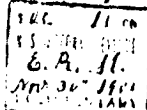
