State of Iowa Madison County SS:

I, Anna Donahue, of said County and State, on oath say that I am the widow of Michael Donahue, who died in Madison County, Iowa, on or about January 29th, 1890; that the Kate Donahue, mentioned in the registry of heirs filed by me as administratrix of the estate of said Michael Donahue is the same and identical person as the Katie Donahue, who was a defendant in the suit brought by me for the partition of the lands belonging to said Michael Donahue, deceased, in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa; that the Margaret Donahue named in the aforesaid registry of heirs is the same and identical person as the Maggie Donahue named as defendant in said partition suit; that the Mary Donahue named in said registry of heirs, and also as defendant in said partition suit is the same and identical person as Mary Lumbard, who joined with her husband J.F. Lumbard in a conveyance to James Donahue on or about May 21st, 1907, of a part of the real estate belonging to said Michael Donahue at the time of his death; that I am the mother of the said Mary Donahue now Mary Lumbard, and of said Margaret or Maggie Donahue, and of Kate or Katie Donahue, and state those facts above of my personal knowledge.
