I, Francis Bennet, of said County and State first being duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am a son and heir at law of Jacob Bennett, deceased, who died testate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about February 1, 1882. That the said Jacob Bennett, this affiant's father, was but once married and that my mother's christian name was Susan. That by said marriage eighteen children were born, twelve of them surviving the age of Fifteen years, the other six having died prior to attaining the age of Fifteen years. That the christian names of the children of the said Jacob Bennett and Susan Bennett who survived the age of fifteen years are as in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of Jacob Bennett, deceased, <sup>show</sup> ~~as in~~ <sup>that he was never married and died</sup> That David Bennett mentioned in said registry of heirs as born in 1882 and died without issue, and that he remained at the home of the said Jacob Bennett and Susan Bennett until the time of his death. That the said Jacob Bennett survived the said Susan Bennett and at the time of his death was an unmarried man. Affiant further says that Hannah Fee, mentioned in said registry of heirs of Jacob Bennett was the oldest child of Jacob Bennett living at the time of the ~~death~~ of Jacob Bennett and that the date of her birth as shown by said registry of heirs is erroneous, the exact date of her birth is unknown to this affiant.
