State of Iowa County of Madison SS:

I, R.E. Lyons of Madison County, Iowa first being duly sworn do depose and say that I am 45 years old, and have lived in Madison County 30 years, and that I was well and personally acquainted with William H. Hollenshead to whom Miles White and wife deeded the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 2-74-26 Aug. 24th 1874, as shown in Deed record 12 on page 245; that on March 25 1879 Wm Hollenshead and wife Mary P. deeded said land to Andrew E. Lyons, as recorded in deed record 16 on page 635 thereof, and that William H. Hollenshead and Wm Hollenshead above mentioned are one and the same person, and that wherever the records show William H. Hollenshead, Wm Hollenshead, Wm Hollingshead, it refers to one and the same person. That I was well and personally acquainted with Fannie C. Chapman to whom on Nov 13 1878 John W. Mann conveyed the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 2-T 74 R 26, as shown by Deed record 16 on page 456; that on Jan 17th 1881 said Fanny C. Chapman conveyed the above described SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 2-74-26 to Andrew E. Lyons as shown by Deed record 19 on page 54, and at the time of said conveyance, said Fanny C. Chapman was an unmarried woman, and that Fannie C. Chapman and Fanny C. Chapman were one and the same identical person, That Andrew E. Lyons who conveyed the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 2-74-26 to James D. Phillips as recorded in Deed record 20 on page 244 was at that time a widower, that is on May 31 1882, the date of the above deed. That James D. Phillips granted to the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 2-74-26 on May 31st 1882, and J.D. Phillips grantor to the same described real estate, as shown by deed record 32 on page 79 on Sept 24th 1891 are one and the same identical person. That John Mairs to whom J.D. Phillips conveyed the above described land, and the said J.D. Phillips have been in actual open continuous and peaceable possession under color of title for the past twenty years. That the deponent has no pecuniary interest in the above, and deponent further sayeth not.
