I, F.W. Fuson, of Madison County, Iowa, on oath say that I am a son of W.T. Fuson and N.M. Fuson to whom was conveyed on or about November 11th 1899, a tract of land in Madison County, Iowa, described as follows: Beginning at the North West corner of Section No. one (1), in Township Seventy five (75) North, of range twenty nine (29), West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, running thence East twenty six (26) rods, thence South thirty seven (37) rods, thence West twenty six (26) rods, thence North thirty seven (37) rods to the place of beginning, containing six (6) acres more or less; that said W.T. Fuson and N.M. Fuson were then husband and wife; that said real estate above described was the only real estate in Madison County, Iowa, in which said W.T. Fuson had any interest whatever at the time of his death; that I am executor of the will of said W.T. Fuson, and was familiar with his affairs both prior and since his death, and that the above described land is that which is referred to in the codicil to his will as the "certain piece of land owned by her and myself in equal partnership, said land is lying seven miles West from Winterset, in Madison County, Iowa." That all the debts and claims against the said W.T. Fuson were paid before his death, and that there are no debts or claims against his estate.
